Test smoke detectors & carbon m	onoxide alarms
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- Declutter, deep clean, and degrease the kitchen
- Use the wand attachment on your vacuum to get rid of excess lint in the dryer vent
- Check your downspouts after a hard rain to ensure water is flowing away from your house
- Winterize your mower and sprinkler system, and cover your patio furniture and grill
- ☐ Check roof overhangs and repair holes or cracks
- □ Trim shrubs, bushes, and trees
- Pull up your annuals (they're gone for good) and mulch around your perennials
- ☐ Have your HVAC serviced. You don't want your system stalling out in the middle of winter

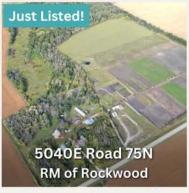
