EXTERIOR

Do you notice that you get a cough, runny nose, and itchy eyes at certain times of the year? This may be due to seasonal allergies, which are caused by plants and mold releasing pollen and spores into the air.

What are the signs of seasonal allergies?

Common seasonal allergy signs and symptoms include:

- Itchy, watery or red eyes
- · Circles under eyes
- · Itchy mouth, nose or throat
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Drainage from the nose down the back of the throat (postnasal drip)
- Temporary loss of smell
- Headache
- Sneezing
- Dry cough
- Tiredness (due to difficulty sleeping from other symptoms)
- Scratchy or sore throat (rarely)
- Snoring (due to congestion)

To know if you have seasonal allergies, you should see a doctor who can give you an official diagnosis through an allergy test. The most common test is a skin prick test, which involves lightly pricking your skin with allergens and monitoring for reactions. If you experience a raised welt or hive at the site of the scratch, you may be allergic to that allergen. If you're unsure if you have allergies, see a doctor who can assess your symptoms and refer you to an allergist if necessary.
