Their decision to move into this small and quiet community would allow them to be close to the city of Winnipeg where they both are employed, Blayne in the Exploration Industry, and Christine an educator. Stony Mountain was also a great place to explore with numerous bike trails, walking paths, and quarry nature preserve to enjoy. The town's atmosphere is both friendly and welcoming and the town itself is rich in history which peaked the interest of this couple. They had always wanted an era perfect backdrop for their treasured antiques and collectables, and "Maggie's House" seemed just perfect! After many hardships and a long learning curve they began to grow more and more strawberries. As demand grew for the berries so did the acres and by the year 2000 they had 10 acres of strawberries. Once they started doing school tours and a corn maze the work load was becoming too great so they sold the dairy cows. Boonstra Farms now has 35 acres of strawberries, 4 acres of raspberries and a 10 acre halloween corn maze. Be sure to check out the maze, take a tour on the hay ride, and last but not least, visit all your favourite animals in the petting zoo!

Fall HOME MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

EXTERIOR

- ✓ Clean gutters and downspouts frequently
- ✓ Check windows and doors for cracks
- M Fertilize lawn
- ▼ Trim shrubs and trees
- ✓ Check the dryer vent and clean if necessary
- ✓ Inspect roof, attic and crawlspace for signs of moisture or damage
- ▼ Remove outdoor hoses
- ▼ Replace any light bulbs that are out

INTERIOR

- ✓ Check smoke detectors and fire extinguishers
- ☑ Repair any loose or damaged windows or door frames
- ✓ Inspect furnace and heating system and replace filters
- ✓ Put caulking or stripping around windows and doors
- ✓ Clean air ducts & furnace (replace filter if dirty)
- ✓ Clean chimney and fireplace
- ✓ Clean baseboards
- ✓ Donate any unwanted clothing or household items


